EDUCATION NOTICE

The City of Longview would like to **thank-you** for your recycling efforts! However, during a recent inspection, we found the following in your recycling container:

- Plastic Bags
Plastic bags are not an acceptable recyclable material. Place your recyclables either directly into the recycling container or place in a paper bag.
- Plastic Containers
Only plastic containers with a 1 or a 2 are an acceptable recyclable material. If you find a different number or cannot find a triangle with a 1 or 2 inside, place the plastic container in your green garbage container.
- Styrofoam
Styrofoam of any kind is not an acceptable recycling material. Place in your green garbage container.
- Wood / Yard waste
Wood product/debris or yard waste is not an acceptable recyclable material. Place in your green garbage container.

Recycling Guidelines

(Brown containers)

- Newspaper, Mixed Paper, and Junk Mail
Paper recyclables MUST BE CLEAN. Remove food, plastic liners, waxed paper or Styrofoam packaging from the inside of boxes. Please do not recycle any paper products that has food product on it like pizza boxes.
- Cardboard
Cardboard recyclables MUST BE CLEAN. Please remove all contents from the box, including food, plastic liners, waxed paper or Styrofoam packaging. FLATTEN all cardboard to conserve space. Please do not recycle any waxed cardboard.
- Glass Bottles and Beverage Jars
Please empty the contents and rinse lightly. No need to remove the paper labels, lids or rings. Any colored or clear glass food or beverage container is acceptable. Please do not recycle window glass or mirrors, drinking glasses or fluorescent or regular light bulbs.
- Aluminum, Steel, and Tin Cans
Please clean and rinse lightly. No need to flatten or remove the paper labels. Please no scrap metal, motor oil or other automotive fluid containers.
- Plastic Containers, Numbers 1 and 2 only
Please empty contents and rinse lightly. Acceptable plastics include milk jugs, soda bottles, laundry detergent and shampoo bottles, margarine tubs and yogurt containers. Please no packing peanuts, Styrofoam, pesticide or other solvent bottles.

Always remember:

"When it doubt - throw it out!"

Garbage Guidelines

Please dispose of household garbage only!
(Green containers)

Please do not throw the following in your green garbage container: hazardous materials, paints, tires, concrete, dirt or sod, automobile parts or fluids, protruding objects or other items too large to fit into the container.
